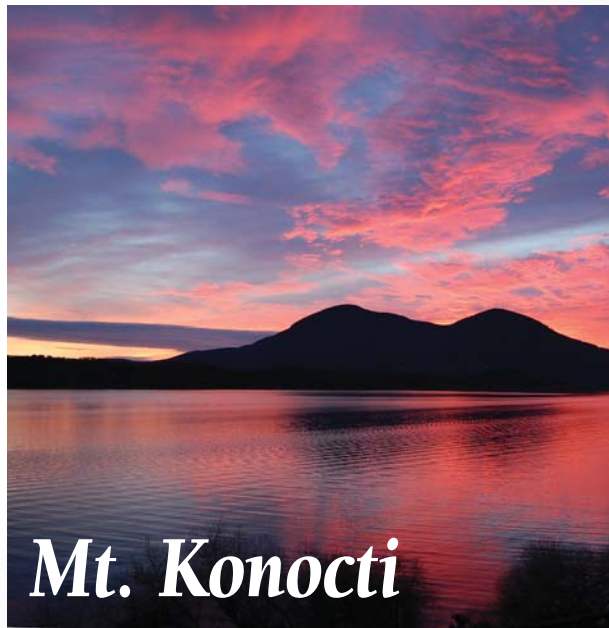

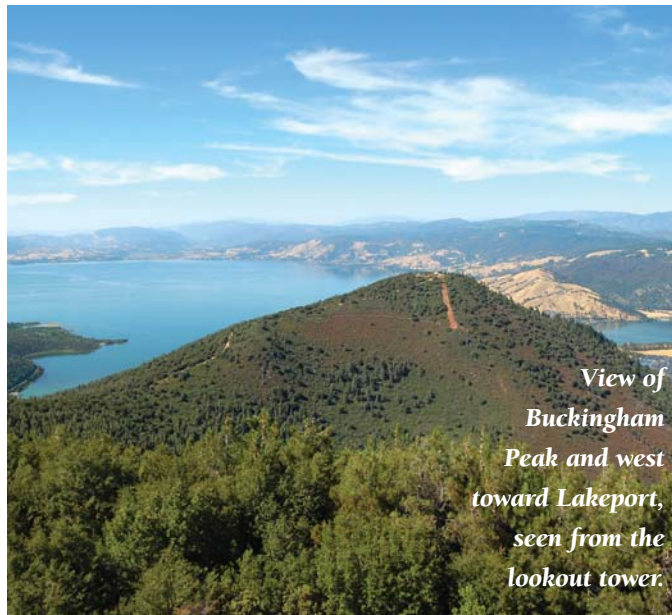

View of Buckingham Peak and west toward Lakeport, seen from the lookout tower.

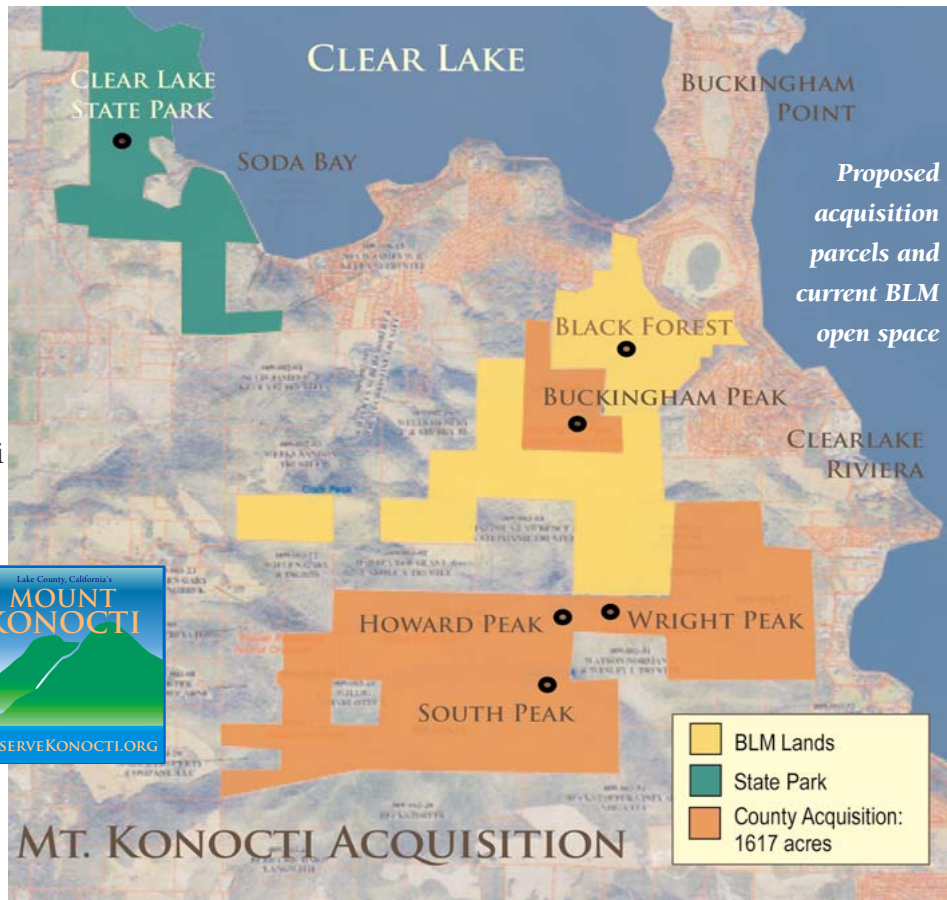
The Mt. Konocti acquisition includes 1512 acres, contiguous with an existing 821 acres of public lands managed by the Bureau of Land Management. Together, this would include the Black Forest, Wright Peak, Howard Peak, South Peak, and Buckingham Peak.

Public donations through September 2009 will help preserve Mt. Konocti and allow the purchase of additional properties.

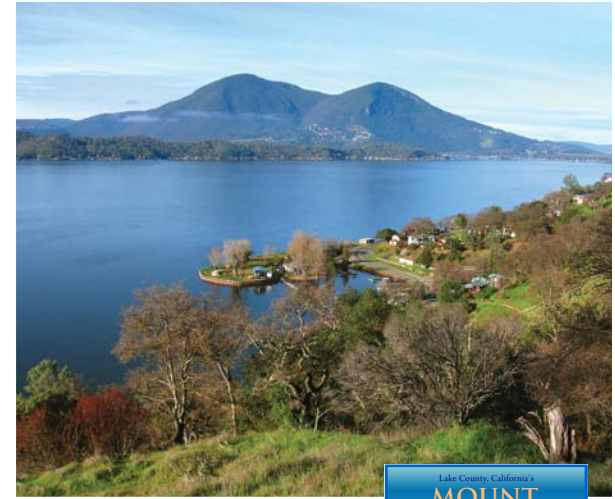
